Acceptable Guarantors & Forms of Identification

Schedule "A" - Acceptable Guarantors

A Guarantor must not be the Customer/Donor/Grantor and must be engaged in one of the following professions in Canada:

1. Chiropractor
2. Dentist
3. Judge
4. Lawyer
5. Magistrate
6. Medical Doctor
7. Notary Public
8. Optometrist
9. Pharmacist
10. Professional Accountant (APA, CA, CGA, CMA, PA, or RPA)
11. Professional Engineer (P.Eng. or Eng.)
12. Veterinarian

Schedule "B" - Acceptable Forms of Identification for POA

The Guarantor must verify the individual's identity by using an original copy of one of the following types of photo identification:

1. Driver's License
2. Canadian Passport
3. Permanent Resident Card
4. Quebec Health Card
5. British Columbia Services Card
6. Provincial Photo Identification Card
7. Certificate of Indian Status Card
